In the light of the recent disastrous drought, which still continues in some areas, and followed by the Bush Fires with some still burning, all of this has ravaged our nation. We need to remember where we have travelled through and thank those many people, some we have met and just think what they have been through. Regional communities do it tough anyway they don't need these extra burdens.

After 18 years the Great Escape has evolved into The Great Escape Oz, a 7 Day Rally.

Still a Fun Car Charity Rally which now supports another arm of Cystic Fibrosis via the **Cure 4 Cystic Fibrosis Foundation**. The Great Escape and now **The Great Escape OZ** is a unique way of visiting parts of Australia that are off the tourist routes and often on your bucket list.

Over the years the areas we travelled through have been affected by one or the other and in cases a double hit.

In 2010 we were on the beautiful Kangaroo Island, now more than half of the island is burnt to the ground.

2014 another island adventure to Tasmania, they didn't miss out this year with fires.

2016 who could forget the floods around Bourke and Louth which prevented us in going to the Birdsville Races.

2017 we were not that far away from the Adelaide Hills which suffered this year from fires.

2018 all that lovely timber area on the Great Dividing Range around Tenterfield, Drake, Casino area and beyond have suffered from the fires.

2019 it felt like the fires and in some areas the floods were tracking us, as the fires around Cooma then across to the coast where we went through Cobargo up into the back of Batemans Bay and Nelligen.



# Yes, 2020 is a 7 Day Rally!

We still travel along off the beaten tracks, but no more off work, away from home and family for 2 weeks. All done from 1 weekend to the next weekend in September each year.

The 2020 rally starts in Nuriootpa (Barossa Valley SA) and ends at Bonus Downs Station, Queensland via Birdsville.

### MINI RALLY: Save the date 28-29 March '20.

As I have indicated in the last Newsletter, I was planning to have a Mini Rally early in the new year but what was going on with the fires I did not want to put more stress in the areas or participates.

Frank and Belinda Corby from Albury have been doing the course layout for the weekend of Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March in the Albury/Hume Weir area.

The plan is to be at the start point around 11am then a 1.5hr course which will take in bush roads, forest tracks and some tar before lunch in Jingellic. Then after lunch onto other track and some scenic roads back to the Hume Weir we would be doing about 240 klms in the mini rally.

There are 2 types of accommodation at the Weir.

- Lake Hume Tourist Park. They have self-contained cabins, camping and power sires.

The next thing we need to work out is the Saturday dinner which could be at the Boat House Restaurant, this is part of the Lake Hume Resort, where you would order your own meals.

The other option is to have a BBQ at the Lake Hume Tourist Park as they have BBQ areas. In regard to brekkie on Sunday morning again at the Tourist Park café we can get Bacon/Egg Rolls etc.

There is no cost in holding the event, it is just pay for your own accommodation, meals and refreshments. I think the tourist park looks the go; we need to come to a decision on catering.

I will be sending further detail out about this "get together/mini rally".

This is a call to save the date; <u>Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March '20</u> be at the start point by 10.30/11am. On Saturday 28<sup>th</sup>.

In advance I would like to thank Frank and Belinda Corby for their time and commitment to make this happen.

Get your registrations in before the mini rally as that will allow me to order the door stickers (with your car # printed on them). I will them bring them with me to the Mini Rally so you can start using them. You must have registered and paid your registration by no later than **February 28, 2020.**
